BENITO BOARDWALK BANDIT(S)
\$500.00 REWARD**

There is a \$500 Reward for information leading to the arrest and prosecution of the person(s) responsible for the damage done to the boardwalk.

On or about February 4th, one 10 foot long section of the railing was broken off into the water. Prior to this incident, on January 26th, 2010 the Benito Boardwalk and park were vandalized with graffiti and unprintable words painted on the playground structure, basketball court (which was recently repainted) basketball backboard, sidewalk, and side rails and walk. Although there is no way to be sure, vandals usually strike close to home. Chances are that someone living in Arbor Greene is responsible for the damage done. Does your child or children know who is responsible?

Damage to the Benito Boardwalk alone averages about \$2,000 per year. The damage done to the boardwalk this time was \$1,290!! That's your money!!!

If you have any information concerning the person(s) responsible, please contact the Arbor Greene Administration Office at 991-9226. Criminal mischief is costly to the residents in Arbor Greene. Continued vandalism and damages to the Benito Boardwalk could result in its closing, causing a great inconvenience to the 40-50 families whose children use the boardwalk to go to and from Benito Middle School.

Arbor Green Landscape Maintenance Schedule for April:

April 5–10: Complete cut back of any remaining cold damaged plant material. Complete spring granular fertilization of turf and shrubs.

April 12–17: Apply pre-emergent weed control on turf areas. Apply fungicide to recently cut back plant material.

April 19–24: Fertilize seasonal color plants in annual flower beds. Apply pre-emergent weed control in planter beds.

April 26–30: Re-fertilize any off color turf areas. Treat plant material for any visible insect activity.

Vehicles Parked on the Street Overnight Will be Towed

Article VIII, Section I, AA of the Arbor Greene Covenants clearly state overnight parking within street rights-of-way by any person is prohibited. This same article gives the Home Owners Association (HOA) authority to tow vehicles parked in violation thereof. The HOA has received complaints that several homeowners are habitually violating this covenant. In several cases, the parking of a vehicle overnight on the street is causing a safety issue. Therefore, **effective April 1, 2010 vehicles found parked overnight on the streets will be subject to towing at owners' expense.**

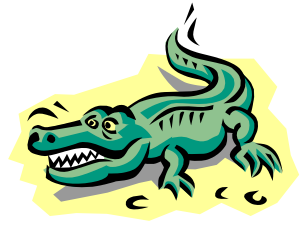
As per the covenants, all garages must be fully occupied with the owner's vehicles. We recognize that in certain cases a homeowner may have more vehicles than can be parked in their garages and on their driveway, and thus may need to park a vehicle on the street. If this is the case, then the homeowner can contact the HOA's property manager, Jeff Couturier at Ameri-Tech; jcouturier@ameritechmail.com or 968-8008 ext.102 and request a variance.

The HOA Board will consider variances on a case by case basis.



Alligator Mating Season

Spring time marks the beginning of the most active and most dangerous season for alligators.



The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission

(FWC) recommend the following guidelines:

- Leave alligators alone. State law prohibits people from killing, harassing or attempting to move alligators.
- Alligators are most active between dusk and dawn.
- Closely supervise children when they are playing by the bank of a lake or pond.
- Do not leave your pet unattended in the community. Sadly, some 'lost pets' have actually been victims of alligator attack because they closely resemble their natural prey.
- Never feed or entice alligators—it is not only dangerous, it's illegal. When fed, alligators overcome their natural instinct for wariness of humans and begin to associate them with food.

Remember, alligators ARE wild animals and we should enjoy their presence here from afar. If you encounter an alligator over four feet in length that poses a threat to humans or property, call the FWC at 1-866-392-4286.

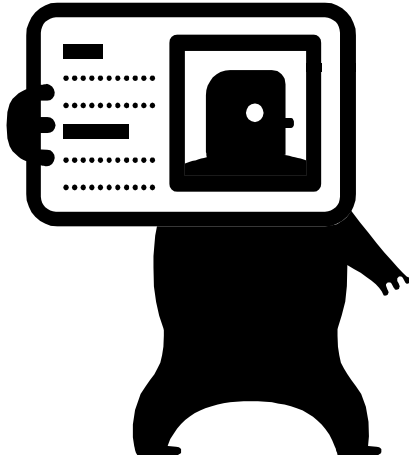

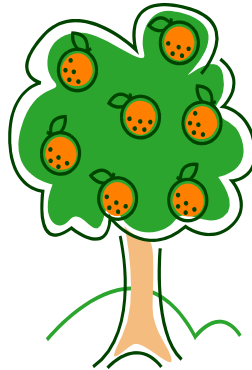

Alabama Changes the Value of pi: The April 1998 newsletter of *New Mexicans for Science and Reason* contained an article written by physicist Mark Boslough claiming that the Alabama Legislature had voted to change the value of the mathematical constant pi. This claim originally appeared as a news story in the 1961 science fiction novel *Stranger in a Strange Land* by Robert A. Heinlein.

A Message from the Neighborhood Watch Directors

Hello Neighbors! We want to thank our Arbor Greene (AG) Neighborhood Watch Association (NWA) group for the exceptional communication over the past few months. The increased e-mail and neighborly communication have highlighted security concerns within our community that we've been able to pass to the Tampa Police Department (TPD), increasing the presence of patrolman throughout the community. We also want to thank the AG Community management, CDD, and HOA, for continued support of our growing program and efforts to keep us all secure in our homes and community.

As members of our NWA group are aware, we work closely with the TPD and disseminate criminal activity reports to our members throughout the week. Unfortunately, the past few months have been filled with criminal activity in the North Tampa area; however, criminal activity has been lower in the active NWA communities. TPD Chief Jane Castor attributes the lower crime rates in NWA communities to the increased communication amongst residents and the TPD. Our NWA group has been steadily growing over the past six months and will only benefit from even more members. 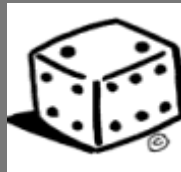
Have you noticed an increase in solicitation within Arbor Greene? Quick thinking residents contacted the TPD right away, which brought more patrols into the community to address some of these suspicious individuals. One NWA member reported a person who rang her doorbell after dark and asked for directions to another home, even though house numbers are on the mailboxes. Another member reported a person ringing the doorbell at 5:30AM Sunday morning, then walked around to the rear of the home to check for opened doors.

Another suspicious individual claimed to be with a security company, asking about residents' alarm systems or lack thereof, and offering to upgrade alarm systems. Most residents responded correctly and immediately by calling the **Tampa Police phone number for Suspicious Activity (813-231-6130)** and reported the suspicious behavior.

One of the consistently reported North Tampa crimes involve people posing as solicitors. These fake solicitors either force their way into the home, or use the fake solicitation as a surveillance method, leading to a later burglary. We ask that if you do not know the person at your door, **please do not open the door**. Our NWA members have read several police reports involving forced entry to homes and apartments when residents open their doors to address the visitor. Many of these residents are either beaten, burglarized, or both. Please encourage your family and neighbors to **immediately report suspicious persons/behavior** in order to help deter crime like this in Arbor Greene.



A few key tips: Get to know your neighbors and **who "belongs"** in your neighborhood. **Lock your doors and windows**, even if you think you're going to be out of your house or vehicle for only a short period of time. **Thieves work all hours** of the day and night, regardless of weather. Criminals like to **pose as utility workers, lawn care workers, solicitors**, etc. and try not to look like criminals. If you have a home or car **alarm**, please **set it** while at home or away, even if you leave your house for a short period of time. In the words of one of our NWA members, "the easiest crime occurs when we are most at ease!" Thank you all for your time and efforts to help make AG a safer place to live.
